

BEnergy 'Budget Advantage' Tariff

Scope of Agreement

1. These terms apply to the BEnergy 'Budget Advantage' Tariff, including Nightsaver, ("the *Tariff*"). This tariff allows customers to avail of a 12 month fixed price contract. The eligibility criteria to avail of the Tariff are as follows:
 - You must be a domestic electricity customer in the Republic of Ireland;
 - You must hold an electricity account with BEnergy to avail of this price plan;
 - You must pay monthly by Direct Debit;
 - You must provide an email and receive online bills.
2. These terms are in addition to the General Terms and Conditions for the Supply of Electricity by BEnergy Ltd to Domestic Premises in Republic of Ireland' ("*BE Energy's General Terms and Conditions*") (as may be amended from time to time and which can be found on our website at www.beenergy.ie or obtained by calling us on Freephone 1800 817 383) and the BE Energy Ltd Customer Agreement Form ("*CAF*").
3. These terms and conditions, together with the BEnergy General Terms and Conditions and the CAF are referred to as the "*Agreement*".
4. In the event of any conflict between these terms, the BEnergy General Terms and Conditions and the CAF, these terms will apply.

Tariff Discount

5. The tariff provides a fixed price tariff during the 12 month contract as set out in the table below. Fixed price means the price to be paid for each unit of energy supplied and any standing charges, as quoted to you when you signed up to the BEnergy 'Budget Advantage' Tariff.

6. Further details regarding the BE Energy 'Budget Advantage' Tariff including Estimated Annual Bill, unit rate and other charges can be viewed on our Tariff Information Page available on our website at www.beenergy.ie/tariffinformation
7. The method of payment for BEnergy 'Budget Advantage' Tariff shall be Monthly Direct Debit. If you do not pay by direct debit, or if you subsequently cancel your direct debit, a €300 deposit will be applied to your account.

8. Your tariff rate will be applied from the date that BEnergy Ltd is registered as your new supplier, or from the date we have agreed, and will continue for 12 months (the "*Tariff Term*").
9. After expiration of the Contract Term your BEnergy account will be switched to the BEnergy 'Standard Tariff' applicable at that time.
10. If you move house during the Contract Term, you may continue to avail of this Contract for the remainder of the Contract Term for electricity supply at your new address, providing you continue to meet the eligibility criteria as set out in paragraph 1.
11. This tariff may not be used in conjunction with any other BEnergy Ltd electricity offer, discount or tariff, unless otherwise specified by BEnergy Ltd during your registration and/or on your CAF.

Ending This Agreement

13. If, at any time, you do not meet the eligibility criteria, as set out in paragraph 1 above, BEnergy Ltd reserve the right to end this agreement and transfer you to the most appropriate tariff at that time and you will be notified of any change using your chosen method of communication
14. You may cancel the Tariff during the 10 working days from when the Agreement is first made ("*Cooling Off Period*") by writing to BEnergy, PO Box 42, Lifford, Donegal, by email to info@beenergy.ie or by calling us on Freephone 1800 817 383. There is no penalty for cancelling your switch during the 'Cooling Off Period'. If you leave the Tariff after the "*Cooling Off Period*" or the Agreement is ended by you at any time before the end of the 12 Month fixed term, a termination charge of €100 (inc VAT) may be applied to your account.

Variations to this Agreement

15. Your Energy product will be billed at the Fixed Price for the duration of the term. Public service obligation and VAT (in addition any additional taxes/government levies that may be introduced during the Agreement duration) will not be fixed at the start of the Agreement and may vary during the term. We will set these items out in your bill so that you know what charges have been required to be passed through to you..
16. BEnergy Ltd reserves the right to withdraw the Tariff without notice at any time prior to the start of the Term.

At the end of the Agreement

17. We will give you notice, between 30 and 60 calendar days (the 30 Days Notice) in advance of the Term of the Agreement coming to an end, using your chosen method of communication. We will notify you of the BEnergy 'Standard Tariff' applicable at that time.
